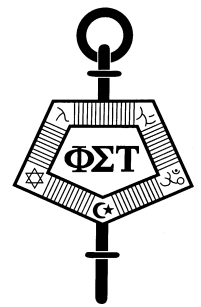

The group will be led by Dr. Eric Silverman, associate professor in the Department. Plantinga is the winner of the 2017 Templeton Prize, a \$1.4 million award that honors a living person who has made an exceptional contribution to affirming life's spiritual dimension. According to Silverman, the reading group will explore fundamental questions such as: What is the distinction between foundational and nonfoundational beliefs? How are foundational beliefs warranted? What is the proper relationship between faith and knowledge? Is the existence of evil compatible with the existence of God? Do any of the traditional arguments for the existence of God succeed? The group of 15-20 students will

meet monthly and culminate in a Skype meeting with Plantinga in the spring. CNU's award is one of only 25 given for the 2017-2018 academic year. (Article from the CNU Newsroom)

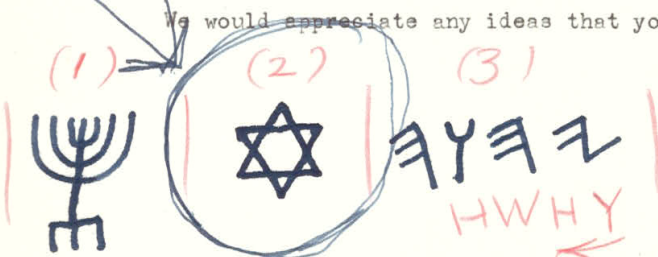
Dear Professor Pfeiffer:

I am writing you on behalf of the Phi Sigma Tau Society, national honor society in philosophy. We are just completing the final arrangements for our organization this month. By the end of this summer we hope to have affiliation with the American Philosophical Association and with the Association of College Honor Societies.

One of the important items in any new society is an emblem. The key which the members will wear will bear the emblem. The initiation service will be centered around the meanings of the insignia. We have decided to have a pentagon-shaped emblem with the letters - Phi, Sigma, Tau - in the center. In each of the five corners we would like to put a symbol to represent each of the five streams of world thought - Chinese, Indian, Islamic, Hebrew, and Greek.

In your opinion, what would be the most significant single symbol to represent Hebrew thought? Perhaps the symbol could be one word, the initial letter in a word, or a sign.

We would appreciate any ideas that you might have on this subject.
